

Work Experience Program

Pacific Magazine's work experience program gives students aged 14 years and over the opportunity to develop a more informed opinion about their possible career options by enabling them to spend time within a publication/office.

Work experience is voluntary and unpaid. It is usually arranged for school students in Years 9 and 10 but may be undertaken by students in Years 11 and 12. Work Experience is also undertaken by students in Tafe and Universities.

All work experience takes place in our Sydney offices located at Media City – 8 Central Avenue, Eveleigh, NSW 2015.

Work experience allows students to:

- Observe a variety of work being done
- Undertake supervised work appropriate to the student's skill level
- Ask questions about the workplace
- Gain skills related to being at work
- Find out about training and employment opportunities
